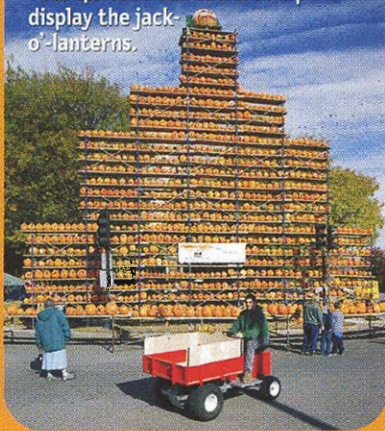
# GUINNESS WORLD RECORDS
